Rule Changes 5 April 2022

The CIHA Announces that the following amendments to the Rules of Racing have been made and will come into effect immediately:

Manual (B)

1. Rule 32 (method of start) is amended as follows:
 - 32.1. Subject to Paragraphs 32.1A and 32.5 all flat races of a distance of twelve furlongs or less must be started by a starting gate approved by the Authority.

32.1A. Any race which is started in front of a crowd must be started with a flag.
 - 32.2. The Starter shall have discretion in flat races greater than twelve furlongs as to whether to start the race by using a starting gate approved by the Authority or by flag.
 - 32.3. Subject to Paragraphs 32.1A and 32.5 all Jump Races having five or more runners must be started by a starting gate approved by the Authority.
 - 32.4. The Starter shall have discretion in Jump Races with four or less runners as to whether to start the race by using a starting gate approved by the Authority or by flag.
