

**Disciplinary Panel – Rules (B) 46.1, (B) 46.2 and (B) 46.3.
3 August 2023**

Fast Tracked

The Judicial Panel Chairwoman, Rowena Scrimgeour, has approved the following sanction under the Channel Islands Horseracing Authority fast-track system:

Jersey Race Club

£10,000 fine – breach of Rules (B) 46.1, (B) 46.2 and (B) 46.3 of the Rules of Racing in that on 7 July 2023 there had been no hurdle attendant at either hurdle in the home straight and the correct procedure had not been carried out when bypassing the third last hurdle during the running of the Channel Islands Champion Hurdle.

In addition, no training had been given to the hurdle attendants relating to the bypassing procedure. This had potentially put at risk the runners' safety, safety of the hurdle attendants and rescuers (such as vets and paramedics).

The breaches were aggravated by the fact that the Jersey Race Club's attention had been specifically drawn to these requirements by the Authority on 12 June 2023.

In respect of each offence the fine is broken down as follows:

- (B) 46.1 (at least one attendant at a hurdle) – £6,667;
- (B) 46.2 (failure to train hurdle attendants) - £1,333; and
- (B) 46.3 (failure to correctly deploy the bypassing procedure) - £2,000.

Half of the fine is to be suspended for a period of twelve months commencing with the date of this decision.
