Prior to Racing:

The Stewards noted that the results from the routine test of, **FLASHY APACHE**, trained by Karl Kukk was declared void as the sample was delayed in transit. The trainer was dually informed.

The Stewards noted that Alice Bond, due to a race card error, should be claiming 3lb instead of 5lb.

The Steward were also informed that, due to a race card error, **JUST JERSEY** in Race Five is declared as wearing blinkers, but in not running in blinkers.

Mr Tett confirmed that his instructions were to deliver the horse as late as possible but at the furlong marker he knew there was nothing there and so he rode hands and heels to the line. The trainer confirmed that she was satisfied with the ride. The Stewards noted the explanation and reminded Mr Tett of his responsibilities to report such behavior to the Stewards in future. Post Racing

The Stewards interviewed Celine De La Haye about her failure to declare riders on two of her horses by the prior day deadline. Miss De La Haye explained that she had been let down at the last minute and had struggled to find available riders in time. The rider she had declared on a number of her horses withdrew around the deadline and she had been scrambling around trying to find a replacement and given the weight differences between her runners. The Stewards informed Miss De La Haye of the reasons the rule was in place and advised her to always make sure a rider was declared at the deadline. The Stewards are always sympathetic to the complexity of riding arrangements and it would be rare for them not to grant a change on the day. No further action was taken.
