Prior to Racing:

The Stewards noted that the results from the routine test of **ALL COST** trained by Martin Dunne came back negative. The trainer was dually informed.

The Stewards noted that at the time of the course inspection there were large and numerous areas of uneven ground between the 7-6f and the 3-2f markers. The Clerk of the Course was notified and addressed the areas. The track was reinspected prior to the commencement of racing.

Permissions

Race 2

Celine De La Haye trainer of **BIRKIE BOY** requested that the horse have a handler at the start.

Race 3

Celine De La Haye trainer of **COUNTESS CIARA** requested that the horse go straight to the start without parading. It was noted that the trainer had declared that the horse was to wear a red hood to the start but the trainer failed to ask for permission on race day. The Stewards will remind the trainer of the protocol for declarations and permissions at the next meeting.

Race 4

Alyson Malzard trainer of **MAQUIGNON** to be last out of the parade ring and if necessary start the race in the second row. The trainer was reminded that the horse must leave the parade ring promptly and it was noted by the stewards that this was indeed the case.

All requests were dually granted.

RACE 1 - 6.30pm

A Handicap Hurdle about TWO MILES AND A HALF

Following the fall of **DIPLOMATIE** the Stewards reviewed the incident and passed on the recommendations from the RMO to the JRC that the ambulance should be guided off the race course by a designated person. The Jockey, Victoria Malzard was treated on course and stood down from racing. The horse, **DIPLOMATIE** was assessed by the Veterinary Team.

Fred Tett, Jockey **BIG UP** reported that the horse pulled up lame and there was an area of uneven footing at the 2f marker. The horse was assessed by the Veterinary Team. The Clerk of the Course addressed the area of concern which was inspected by the Inspector of Race Courses.

Racing was delayed by 20 minutes, with a knock on delay for all races for the remainder of the meeting.

RACE 2 – 7.05pm (off time delayed until 7.25pm)

**RACE 3 – 7.40pm (off time delayed until 8.45pm)
A Handicap about SIX FURLONGS**

**Race 4 – 8.15pm (off time delayed until 8.45pm)
A Handicap about ONE MILE AND FIVE FURLONGS**

The start of the race was delayed by a further five minutes due to **TUCK YOUR SHIRT IN** and **FLASHY APACHE** being incorrectly saddled. Both horses were unsaddled, the Jockeys returned to the weighing room, reweighed and the horses dually resaddled.

Karl Kukuk trainer of both horses was asked to comment. The trainer stated that it had been a very long day and put the mix up down to human error. The Stewards accepted this response and took no further action.

Noted note: The delay was communicated directly to the commentator and the Clerk of the Scales to keep them abreast of the situation with a radio call, Stewards sent with both Jockeys to the weighing room and a Steward set directly to the Judges Box.

**Race 5 – 8.50pm (off time delayed until 9.10pm)
A Handicap about ONE MILE AND A QUATER**

The Stewards noted that there was a change in colors for **KINGS SQUARE (UK)**. The changes were noted on the board and communicated to the Commentator.

The Stewards ordered the routine testing of the winner of the race, **BETWEEN THE COVERS** trained by Karl Kukuk.
